

Guess Who's Coming For Dinner?

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Guess Who's Coming for Dinner?

Guess Who's Coming for Dinner is an opportunity for you to share a meal and fellowship together with a small group of people (4-10) from Good Shepherd whom you might not normally have a chance to meet.

Why would I want to be a host?

The advantage of signing up as a host is that you will know where you're going (your own home) and who will be coming to your home. You will be contacted by the Guess Who committee and given the names of your guests. It will be your responsibility to contact the guests, invite them to your home, and send them directions.

Why would I want to be a guest?

The advantage of signing up to be a guest is that you get to be surprised about where you will be going for dinner and who you will be sharing the meal with. You will be responsible to bring a dish for your family and others around the table. There is no need for you to clean up your home if you are a guest because no one will be coming to your home.

What if I want to be a host and a guest?

You are welcome to sign up twice or even three times if you are free on April 16th, 17th, and 18th, but remember, you need to bring food for each time that you sign up.

Will it be complete strangers with whom I will be sharing a meal?

No! The Guess Who's committee will try to match people with some friends and some new faces at each table. In this way, you will be comfortable with a few people, but get to know other people as well.

When will it be?

Friday, April 16th for dinner
Saturday, April 17th for dinner or
Sunday, April 18th for lunch

Who will be participating?

Guess Who's Coming for Dinner is for everyone – young and old, professional chefs or amateurs. The only thing that qualifies you to participate is that you want to eat together with others from the Good Shepherd Family.

Where will I go?

You will not know who's house you are going to or who you will be eating with until the week before (this is part of the surprise). If you sign up by March 21st, the Guess Who's committee will arrange the groupings and contact the hosts with the names of the guests. The hosts will then have 2 weeks to contact the guests and give them directions to their home.
